4. Financing

The project is financed by the European Union, in accordance with the rules of Joint Operational Programme Romania – Republic of Moldova 2014-2020 and the Regulation (EU) No 236/2014. The project is co-financed by Nisporeni District Council.

CONTRACT SPECIFICATIONS

6. Description of the contract

Improving the quality of the road connecting the Varzaresti Monastery (and Varzaresti Village) with the other territories of Nisporeni District, in order to short-cut the way from Nisporeni City



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(and the regions located at N-E, E and S-E from Nisporeni) to the international road M1: border with Romania-Leuseni-Chisinau-Dubasari-border with Ukraine and to create the best road solution for the traffic coming from Ungheni (Republic of Moldova) to Albita (Romania).

7. Number and titles of lots

TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

8. Eligibility and rules of origin

Participation is open to all natural persons who are nationals of and legal persons (participating either individually or in a grouping – consortium - of tenderers) which are effectively established in a Member State of the European Union or in a eligible country or territory as defined under the Regulation (EU) N°236/2014 establishing common rules and procedures for the implementation of the Union's instruments for external action (CIR) for the applicable Instrument under which the contract is financed (see also heading 22 below) . Participation is also open to international organisations. All supplies under this contract must originate in one or more of these countries. However, they may originate from any country when the amount of the supplies to be purchased is below 100, 000 euros per purchased.

9. Grounds for exclusion

Tenderers must submit a signed declaration, included in the Tender Form for a Works Contract, to the effect that they are not in any of the situations listed in point 2.3.3 of the **Practical Guide**.

10. Number of tenders

Tenderers may submit only one tender per lot. Tenders for parts of a lot will not be considered. Any tenderer may state in its tender that it would offer a discount in the event that its tender is accepted for more than one lot. Tenderers may not submit a tender for a variant solution in addition to their tender for the works required in the tender dossier.

11. Tender guarantee

No tender guarantee is required.

12. Performance guarantee

The successful tenderer will be asked to provide a performance guarantee of 6% of the amount of the contract at the signing of the contract. This guarantee must be provided together with the return of the countersigned contract no later than 30 days after the tenderer receives the contract signed by the Contracting Authority. If the selected tenderer fails to provide such a guarantee



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within this period, the contract will be void and a new contract may be drawn up and sent to the tenderer which has submitted the next cheapest compliant tender.

13. Information meeting and/or site visit

No information meeting is planned.

14. Tender validity

Tenders must remain valid for a period of 90 days after the deadline for submission of tenders. In exceptional circumstances, the Contracting Authority may, before the validity period expires, request that tenderers extend the validity of tenders for a specific period.

SELECTION AND AWARD CRITERIA

16. Selection criteria

Economic and financial capacity of candidate:

- the average annual turnover of the tenderer in the past 3 years must be at least EUR 700.000.
- if it is the sole tenderer, it must have access to sufficient credit and other financial facilities to cover the required cash flow for the duration of the contract. In any case, the amount of credit available must exceed the equivalent of EUR 100.000.

Technical and professional capacity of candidate:

- it must have completed contracts of the same nature with a cumulative value of at least 500.000 Euro during the following period: 5 years from the submission deadline. The Contracting Authority reserves the right to ask for copies of certificates of final acceptance signed by the supervisors/contracting authority of the projects concerned.

(This means that the project the tenderer refers to could have been started/implemented/completed at any time during the indicated period but it does not necessarily have to be started and completed during that period, nor implemented



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during the entire period.)

- it must carry out at least 70 % of the contract works using its own resources, which means that it must have the equipment, materials, human and financial resources necessary to carry out that percentage of the contract.
- if it is the lead member of a joint venture/consortium, it must be able to carry out at least 50 % of the contract works using its own means.
- if it is a partner of a joint venture/consortium (i.e. not the lead member) it must be able to carry out at least 10 % of the contract works using its own means.
- all its key staff must have at least 3 years' appropriate experience and proven qualifications relevant to works of a similar nature to this project.

17. Award criteria

The most economically advantageous tender is the technically compliant tender with the lowest price.

Subsequent to the initial contract resulting from the current tender procedure, new works consisting in the repetition of similar works, up to the estimated amount of 21.721,00 EUR (representing contingency reserve), may be entrusted to the initial contractor by negotiated procedure without prior publication of a contract notice, provided the new works are in conformity with the same basic project.
